## Andean trout, alpaca steak and traditional crayfish soup on the new menu at Hotel Libertador Arequipa

The restaurant at Hotel Libertador Arequipa has introduced a new food and beverage menu with a wide variety of dishes that bring together traditional Peruvian flavors and the latest gastronomical trends.

This new menu offers a variety of appetizers and entrees. The entrees are categorized according to the ingredients used in their preparation. There are “**Surf**” dishes, such as grilled Andean trout with yams and hot crayfish *ceviche*, baked sea bass with asparagus risotto, corn, carrot and *tumbo* fruit chutney.



There are also “**Turf**” dishes, among which grilled alpaca steak served with fettuccini with sage and mushroom sauce, grilled lamb with ratatouille and manioc croquettes in lamb sauce with cocoa, baked chicken breast, mushroom crust with green asparagus, carrot purée with tarragon sauce, as well as fried brisket served with browned yellow potatoes and sautéed spinach with Creole sauce.

On this menu, there are also options for pasta lovers, such as fettuccini in creamy sage sauce, glazed ham and mushrooms, as well as ravioli filled with vegetables and cream of Andean herbs.

Appetizer choices include traditional regional dishes such as stuffed hot peppers, crayfish soup and a typical vegetable and cheese salad known as “soltero de queso”. Additionally, there are alpaca carpaccio, watercress and arugula salad with balsamic vinegar, sea bass *ceviche* with glazed sweet potato and corn, sautéed seafood Napoleon with fried banana, *muna* oil and *chicho* (an aromatic herb), and caprese salad with cheese and elderberry vinaigrette, among other options.

Hotel Libertador Arequipa, the first five-star hotel in the city, is located five minutes away from the historic colonial center of the city, which has been declared Cultural Heritage of Mankind, and fifteen minutes from the Rodríguez Ballón Airport. The hotel has the most modern infrastructure and facilities, in order to ensure a pleasant stay in the White City.

Hoteles Libertador Peru has six hotels in strategic cities that stand out for their tourist attractions: Arequipa, Cusco, Lima, Puno, Trujillo and Paracas, in addition to the new hotel construction projects in Urubamba and Lima.

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
